Adams Dairy Bank (in organization) Moves Closer to Opening

Organizers Break Ground for Blue Springs Newest Community

BLUE SPRINGS, Mo.: October 10, 2007: Adams Dairy Bank (*in organization*) broke ground Wednesday at the future site of Blue Springs newest community bank. Pending regulatory approvals the proposed bank will be located near the northwest corner of I-70 and Coronado Drive in Blue Springs.

The ground breaking ceremony commenced with a welcome from proposed President David Chinnery. “Our proposed bank – Adams Dairy Bank – is being organized by a committed group of local community leaders that know the community of Blue Springs.
